

Community Engagement Requirements – Advocacy Checklist

- Review the [Caregiver Nation Network Advocacy Toolkit](#).
- Draft and send a letter to your State Medicaid Director, Governor, State Aging Director, and relevant state lawmakers overseeing Medicaid, using the [toolkit template](#). Personalize the letter with state-specific caregiving data and stories where possible.
- Share a copy of the letter with [your U.S. Senators and Representatives \(find out who your legislators are at this link\)](#) to elevate state-level concerns.
- Collect stories from family caregivers who rely on Medicaid subsidies for ACA coverage. Stories may be included in your letter, referenced in an op-ed, or shared on social media.
- Identify 1–2 family caregivers willing to speak with state officials or the media about the impact of potential Medicaid coverage loss on themselves and their families.
- Use data from [Caregiving in the U.S. 2025: Caring Across the States](#) and [your state's caregiving data profile](#) to educate policymakers.
- Amplify your advocacy by sharing letters, caregiver stories, and data through social media.
